TBI, CTE & PTSD IN THE MILITARY

There's an urgent need to better understand how TBI, CTE and PTSD are related. TBI from blast overpressure (BOP) and low-level blast (LLB) have been identified as new types of brain injury, but their effects on the brain and body still aren't fully understood. Since 2000, more than 533,000 service members have been diagnosed with a TBI. Those who have experienced a TBI are at higher risk for depression, anxiety, cognitive problems, substance abuse, violence and suicide.
